**NOTED GERMAN – UTICA HAS A SAINT** – Saint Marianne Cope was born in Germany in 1838 and declared a saint at the Vatican on October 21, 2012. She came to Utica at age 2, joined the Franciscan Order in 1862; taught at St. Joseph's School in Utica; Administrator at St. Joseph's Hospital in Syracuse; managed St. Elizabeth's Hospital in Utica; worked with lepers of Molokai and founded Maui's first hospital; founded a home for daughters of leprosy patients and remained free of leprosy till death.
