GERMAN/AMERICAN DAY – It is important as a German Cultural Social Club that we celebrate October 6th as we are reminded of the first Germans to enter the United States in 1683. Thirteen Mennonite families from Krefeld Germany arrived at Philadelphia Harbor on board the Vessel Concord and founded the settlement of Germantown.

FLAG RAISING - Our Club will celebrate German American Day as the chorus will raise the German Flag at Hanna Park, Utica City Hall, while singing the German National Anthem as well as the American National Anthem followed by a brief mini concert on **October 4th at 11 a.m.** Also note that the Friday Dinner Special at the Club on Oct. 4th is **Schnitzel**, in celebration of German/American Day.

(German-American Journal Sept./Oct./Nov. 2024). Close to 45 million of Americans have German ancestry. In NY State, more than 9% of the total population of 19.6 million can claim German heritage.
